

Canadian Certified Fire Investigator Level C Designation

Applicant Declaration

- I acknowledge that attainment of the CCFI-C designation indicates that the applicant has been tested and meets or exceeds required knowledge and job performance requirements necessary to conduct origin and cause investigations based on the most recent editions of NFPA 921: Guide for Fire & Explosion Investigations and NFPA 1033: Standard for Professional Qualifications for Fire Investigator and does not necessarily constitute endorsement or recommendation by the Canadian Association of Fire Investigators.

The Canadian Association of Fire Investigators does not endorse or recommend, assume responsibility for, or bear any liability either directly or indirectly for any errors or omissions, damage or loss caused or alleged to be caused, or negligence in conjunction with an individual's actions and use of the CCFI-C designation.

- I authorize the Canadian Association of Fire Investigators to conduct a thorough background and character investigation, or verify information provided by me, prior to my acceptance as a candidate for the CCFI-C designation if required.
- I will remain current in fire training by attending formal education courses, workshops, and seminars and/or through professional publications and journals.
- I swear that the CCFI-C exam will be completed entirely on my own, I will not discuss any aspect of the exam with any other person, that I will neither receive any unauthorized assistance nor utilize any reference materials, and that I will not make or keep a copy of the exam.
- I acknowledge that the application fee to write the CCFI-C exam is not refundable and does not guarantee that I will pass the exam.
- I acknowledge that a minimum score of 75% correct answers is required to receive the CCFI-C designation.
- I acknowledge that I can apply to rewrite the CCFI-C exam after a period of 30 days if I fail to achieve a passing grade.
- I acknowledge that information I provide to CAFI will be truthful and not inaccurate or misleading.
